#### **BOAT LAUNCHING FACILITIES:**

Goolwa Aquatic Club – 2 ramps, floating jetty, extensive parking, toilets.

#### **BOAT MOORING AREA:**

Goolwa wharf effluent station – protected moorings, floating jetties for boats up to 40 feet. Jetties nearby for larger vessels.

#### FRIDAY 22<sup>nd</sup> FEBRUARY 5-8PM:

Cittaslow free live music on the lawns of Signal Point. BYO food or there are several food outlets to choose from. Wine can be purchased by the glass or bottle. BYO chairs, walking distance from mooring area.

#### SATURDAY 23rd FEBRUARY:

10AM – Depart Goolwa and cruise downstream, pass through the Goolwa lock, past 19<sup>th</sup> Beacon boat ramp to moor at the public jetty at Sugars Beach. NB: Flares required and no dogs allowed. Coorong Café serves fish and chips and other seafood or BYO lunch. For those interested, cross the mouth and cruise down to Godfreys Landing (no jetty) and walk across the dunes to the Southern Ocean. Return to Goolwa. For those without boats you can drive to Sugars Beach via Hindmarsh Island Bridge.

5PM – Club drinks on the Goolwa jetty and walk to the Goolwa Hotel for dinner.

#### SUNDAY 24th FEBRUARY:

10AM – Depart Goolwa and cruise upstream to tie up at the Clayton Jetty. BYO barbecue lunch at the reserve near the jetty. Shelter, bbq, tables, chairs provided, toilets nearby. Cruise back to Goolwa to retrieve boats. For those without boats you can drive to Clayton.
